

(For example, any song about the termination of a relationship will not be played.) And although your disc jockey has an extensive library of mainstream music, there is a possibility that a specific song may not be available. (for example: a particular "oldie", an ethnic song or a "one-hit-wonder") Please list below any of these song titles and artists that you definitely want to hear or any special dedications you want played at your reception. We will then verify with your disc jockey that these songs are available. If any of these are not part of your disc jockey's library and you own any of these songs on compact disc, feel free to bring them with you. They will be returned to the bride & groom, maid of honor or best man at the end of the evening.
